## Verb TO BE

### PRESENT SIMPLE

*El verbo TO BE equivale a “SER” y “ESTAR” en español, dependiendo del contexto de la frase. Conjugado con los pronombres personales sería:*

*Yo soy / estoy – Tú eres / estás – Él es / está – Ella es / está ...*

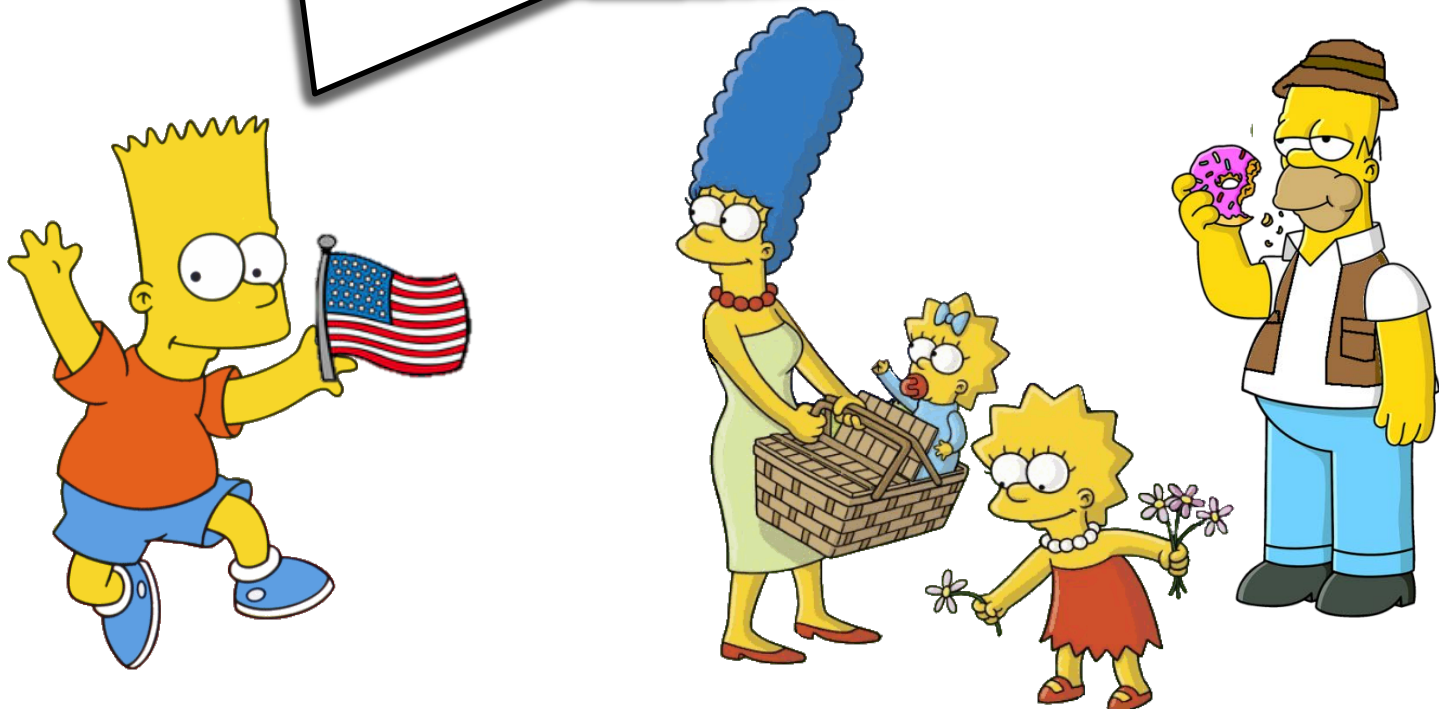
*Nosotros somos / estamos – Vosotros sois / estáis – Ellos son / están*

# Verb TO Be AFFIRMATIVE

I **am** Bart.

I **am** with my family.

I'**m** American.



# Verb TO Be AFFIRMATIVE

You **are** my friend.  
You're a good boy.



# Verb TO Be

## AFFIRMATIVE

He **is** Homer.  
He'**s** my dad.



# Verb TO Be

## AFFIRMATIVE

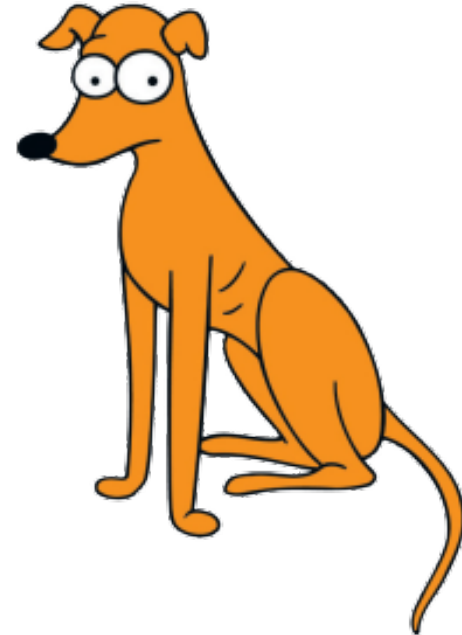
She **is** Marge.  
She'**s** my mom.



# Verb TO Be

## AFFIRMATIVE

That **is** a dog.  
It'**s** my pet.



# Verb TO Be AFFIRMATIVE

**We are** friends.

**We're** at school.



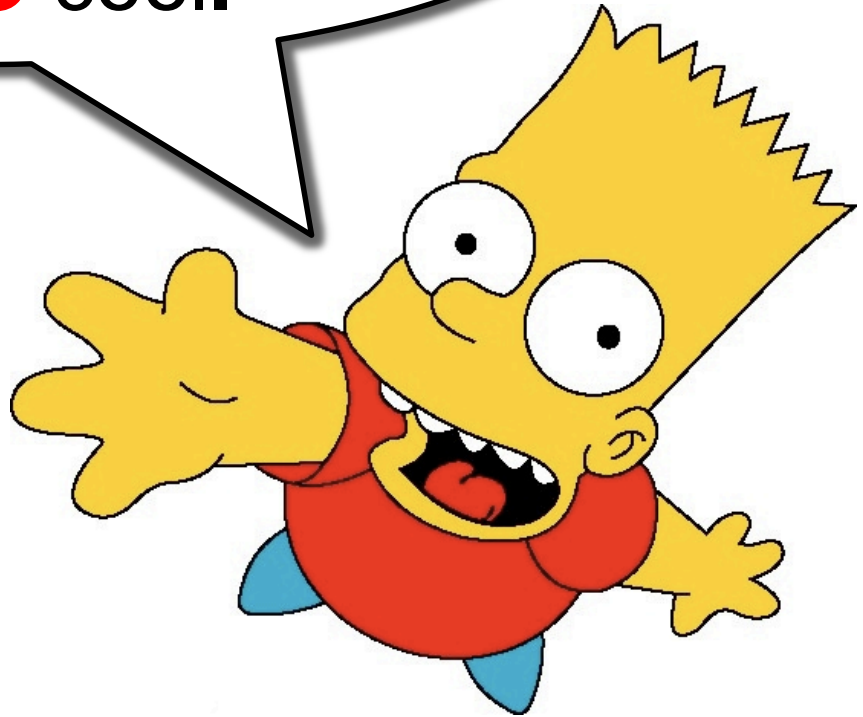
# Verb TO Be

Remember

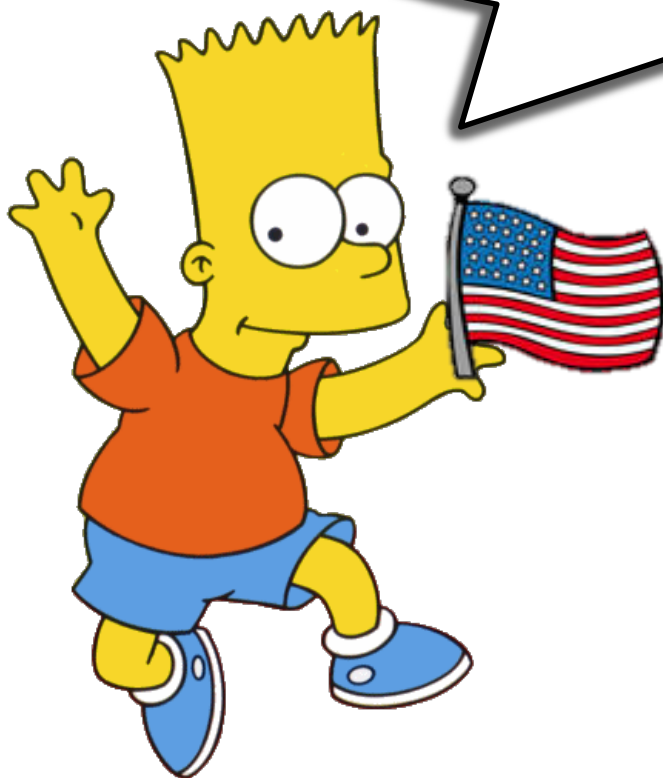


# Verb TO Be

## NEGATIVE

**I am not** from Britain.

**I'm not** British.



# Verb TO Be

## NEGATIVE

She **is not** Marge.

She **isn't** my mom.



# Verb TO Be

## NEGATIVE

We **are not** from Mexico.

We **aren't** Mexican.





# Verb TO Be

## NEGATIVE

I'm not

You aren't

He isn't

She isn't

It isn't

We aren't

You aren't

They aren't

# Verb TO Be INTERROGATIVE

**Am** I your best friend?

Yes, **you are**.



# Verb TO Be INTERROGATIVE

**Are** you my teacher?



Yes, I **am**.





# Verb TO Be INTERROGATIVE

**Is** she your mom?

No, she **isn't**.

## QUESTIONS

Am I ?

Are you ?

Is he ?

Is she ?

Is it ?

Are we ?

Are you ?

Are they ?

## SHORT ANSWERS

Yes, I am/you are

No, I'm not/you aren't

Yes, he/she/it is

No, he/she/it isn't

Yes, we/you/they are

No, we/you/they aren't

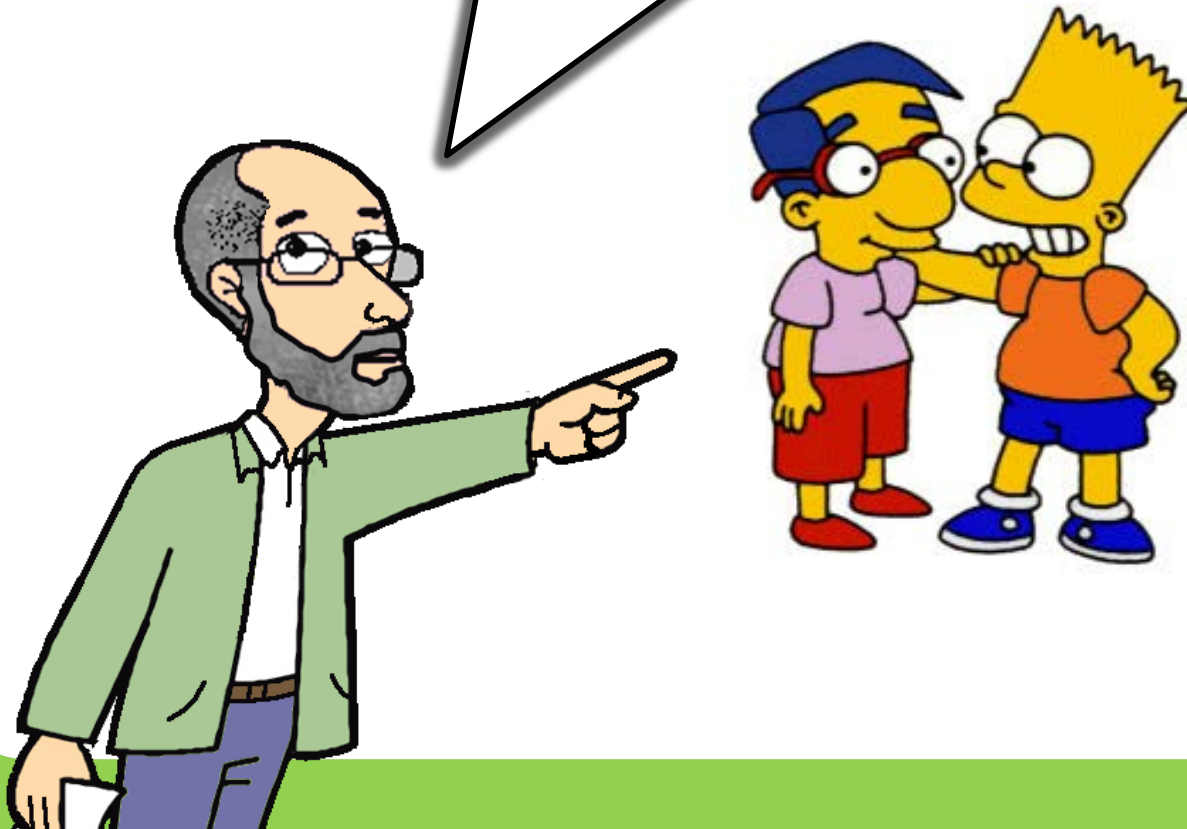
