SPELLING OF -S IN 3RD.P.SING. (HE/SHE/IT)

RULE

Add an -S to the Base form of the verb

I work - He works You live - It lives We want - She wants

BUT

- Verbs ending in -O / -S / -SH / -CH / -X add -ES
 I go He goes You kiss It kisses We wash She washes
 I watch He watches You relax She relaxes
- Verbs ending in -CONSONANT + Y- add -Y-IES
 I study He studies You fly It flies We cry She cries

PRESENT SIMPLE TENSE - USE

We use **Present Simple** to talk about routines, habits, permanent situations and general truths.

RUTINAS y HÁBITOS

TALKING ABOUT REGULAR ACTIONS, ROUTINES AND HABITS

We use it to talk about things we do regularly.

Examples: "I play soccer every Saturday."

"They go to school by bus every morning."

"I eat breakfast at 7:00 AM."

SITUACIONES PERMANENTES GUSTOS, HOBBIES

FACTS, LIKES AND HOBBIES

We use it to describe permanent facts and things we like.

Examples: "She lives in Madrid"

"They work in the factory"

"She likes coffee and loves cooking"

VERDADES UNIVERSALES

GENERAL TRUTHS

We use it to state facts that are always true.


Examples: "Water boils at 100 degrees Celsius."

"The sun rises in the east."

"Elefants don't eat meat"

AFTER "BE"

HE IS NEVER LATE FOR SCHOOL

I AM OFTEN READY FOR WORK AT 6 AM.

I USUALLY GO TO BED AT 11

SHE NEVER EATS MEAT

HE OFTEN VISITS HIS GRANDFATHER
